CHERISHING OLD MEMORIES

An Evening With Ervad Rustomji Nariman Kanga at Belgaum

During his visit to Belgaum last year, P.T. Reporter **Khushroo P. Mehta** had an emotional and memorable interview with Ervad Rustomji Nariman Kanga. With all due respects to the departed soul, P.T. Reporter **Khushroo Mehta** shares the life of this great man with us.

During the 25 years of our stay at Belgaum, there was one family that we were very close to and that was the family of Ervad Rustomji Kanga. His two sons and a daughter were class mates to each of us brothers and sister. We spent the best times of our lives together as friends at school and at the Parsi Club in Belgaum. We made a great team hence we always got selected for a Parsi play or a Shakespeare drama on stage during the annual Navroze function held at the Parsi Club. I personally know Ervad Rustomji Kanga as the pious Dasturji of the Belgaum Agiary who was always good to everyone and performed his duties with the highest level of sincerity and dedication. He always followed the discipline of the Agiary timings and one could find him sitting on a chair at the front entrance of the Agiary even after he finished his prayers and work at the Agiary. He was always loud and clear in his prayer recitals and humble in his tone towards all Bedins. Whenever I meet him, I am

always reminded of the good old days that our families spent together at Belgaum. I visited him one evening at his bungalow, where he now stays; after his retirement from the Belgaum Agiary, with his second son Jamshed and his family. In a first exclusive chat with Parsi Times, Ervad Rustomji Kanga reminds me of the golden period of our lives again. Excerpts:
P.T.: Sahebji Dasturji, How are you? Today I have come to hear you speak about your life and experiences which will be shared with our PT readers. So tell us something about yourself and your family background.

Ervad Kanga: Sahebji Khushroo, I am fine. I am happy that you are now with Parsi Times. I have read the copies you sent to me by post earlier and find them interesting. You already know much about my life and my family, however for the benefit of P.T. readers, let me start again. I am Rustomji Nariman Kanga, born on 26th March 1936 at Navsari. My forefathers were all Mobeds

and ours was a Dastur family. I completed my Navar studies at the Dadar Madressa.

P.T.: When did you first become a Mobed and in which Agiary was your first assignment?

Er. Kanga: I still remember very well that I was just 16 years, when I joined my father as a Dastur at the Badnera Agiary. The year was 1952 and from that time until 1977, I dedicated 25 years of my life to the Agiary there. I worked under my father as a Mobed.

P.T.: Great! That's a long time in religious service. What memories can you recollect of your time at Badnera?

Er. Kanga: The biggest memories of that place are that Badnera gave me my family. I was married there and all my three children were born there. Apart from that my routine services at the Agiary had no special memories to share.

P.T.: How did Belgaum come to you? And which year did it all happen?

Er. Kanga: In the year 1977, the Zoroastrian population of Badnera had reduced to a handful of Parsi families.

There wasn't much work and my father was already there at the Agiary. Since Ervad Kekobad Govadia was retiring from Belgaum and there was a requirement for a Mobed here, I opted to come here with my family.

P.T.: Dasturji, I remember that you retired in the year 2003; as I was present at your farewell function. So what memories would you like to share with our readers of the time you served at the Boyce Agiary, Belgaum?

Er. Kanga: YES! It was indeed one of the longest period of

services by a Mobed at the Boyce Agiary. A total of 27 years, during which I saw you and most of the Zoroastrian population at Belgaum as kids, grow up to become young men and women. The outlook of the new generation towards our religion changed and I was hurt to see it happen. However I appreciated the unity some of you kids showed in coming together to religiously clean the Agiary on every Sunday.

P.T.: Do you remember having started something

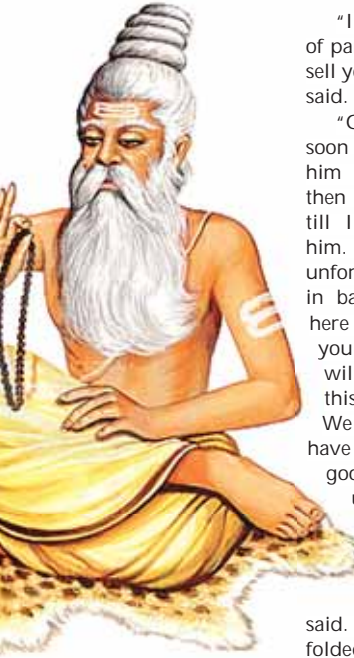
rich wife of a very rich and a well known

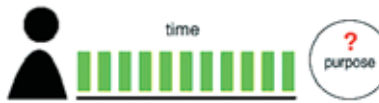

bike every day. He may be efficient but even if he caught up with me would he be effective? Was his effort of running behind the motor bike meeting any objective at all? The dog may have been efficient but may not be effective. This unfortunately reminds me about myself. Running behind things, trying to run fast, trying to be on time, trying to

do it in the most efficient way and then realizing am I really meant to do all this? Am I happy? Well, till date I have not got any answers. May be I am waiting for the emergency which will create the situation and I will decide my priority.

There was a need for a service engineer as a large manufacturing set up could not get the assembly line operational again. The Equipment manufacturers had given up and could not solve the problem. They

finally got one of the service companies send in their expert and after some looking around he tapped the equipment gears and the assembly line was back to working. When he sent his invoice the company was surprised to find a bill for Rs. 10 lakhs! They needed the breakup of why the amount was Rs. 10 lakhs? A week later when they received the bill it read Point1) Travel Expenses-Rs. 200/- 2) knowing where to tap the equipment - Rs. 999800/-.

This service engineer was not necessary efficient but he was effective. For happiness, success or whatever we want I am sure Effectiveness precedes Efficiency. Knowing what to do, what should be given priority, the time and place to do it is all a part of effectiveness. It may not be planned but our experience and learning over time, getting the right mentors in all aspects of life can allow us to move to being effective.

different by yourself and being appreciated for it during your long tenure at the Boyce Agiary?

Er. Kanga: I wanted the bedins to be more participating during the Jashans that I performed on all the holy

days of the month and during our festivities. So I started the "Hum-Bandagi" after every Jashan. I also collected important information on the significance of the particular day of the Jashan and presented a small talk each time. This was highly appreciated by all the Bedins

present and I got compliments for that.

P.T.: If you were to pick up one of the two places that you served as a Dasturji, which one would you name?

Er. Kanga: Ofcourse, Belgaum. That is the reason I decided to stay back here even after my retirement and built our own house. I liked this place right from the time I first came to serve as a Mobed at the Agiary. This city has got its usual calm and the general nature of the people is very helpful. The climate here is very good for retired people.

P.T.: Dasturji, there is always a discussion on the shortage of Mobeds at Agiaries in smaller cities all over India. What is your view on it? Did you enjoy a good pay scale during your tenure?

Er. Kanga: You are right Khushroo. Today the new generation of Mobeds isn't attracted towards Agiary of small cities and towns, simply because the Anjuman there aren't able to pay them well.

In comparison Big Cities give them all facilities and an overall better life. When I joined in 1977 my salary here was just Rs. 450/- a month. Twenty seven years later, I retired at a salary of Rs. 4,500/- a month. All I got as my retirement benefit was a month's salary. Now can you call this good? Since then the times have changed, however the Mobeds in the smaller cities and towns are still not paid well.

P.T.: That really is a concern. What would you like to tell our P.T. readers on this point and in general?

Er. Kanga: I want to request to the entire Zoroastrian Community that they as a whole should show more responsibility in taking special genuine care for the welfare of our Mobeds and Panthakis. If this is not done on priority, going ahead it will become extremely difficult to find Navars who would like to take up this job happily, leading to forceful closures of many

Agiaries.

P.T.: Our religion is said to be the purest and our prayers the most powerful. Can you share any one which can be of help to our P.T. readers in their difficult times?

in gold and only hold upto 5% to 7% of their respective portfolio asset allocation. Most of them had given into the belief that prices of gold can never fall, it has only one way movement and that is going up. To me it came as no surprise as gold is no different from other asset classes. (what goes up has to come down, what is down will one day go up).

I remember in June 2007, when we were shopping for my sister's wedding, gold was quoting at 12600/10gms. When I got married in December 10 we purchased it at 19800/10gms. In December 2012 when I gifted my wife a gold ring for our 2nd marriage anniversary I had to shell out approx 30100/10gms. Last month i.e. June'13 we had our baby shower, and I was very happy to buy her a gold chain which cost me around 26580/10gms. If you see the run up in gold prices from 5600/10 gms in 2003 to 33000/10 gms in 2012 had all the features of the bubble (as we call it in equities). And now like any other

As I am writing this, the price of Gold per 10 grams is Rs. 23,486 for 22 carat and Rs. 25,645 for 24 carat in Mumbai. Not very long ago, in September 2012 the price of gold was hovering around Rs. 32,000 - 33,000 range. But all of a sudden, in the last few months, the price of gold is witnessing a freefall.

Financial experts claim that gold has never seen such fluctuations in the last 30 years. In fact, the price was always increasing year on year. The report



further claims that such huge global drop in gold prices has been seen after 1981.

Gold is down 17% since mid-April, and has lost 23% this year (CYTD), and is on record for its biggest annual drop since 1981. In fact I happened to read somewhere in newspapers that it has already recorded its worst quarter in history by plunging 21% from April 13 - Jun 13.

I have been regularly advising my clients to stay away from speculating

asset class gold bubble is deflating, slowly but surely.

Let us try to analyse the contributing factors for the Bull Run in gold.

Gold prices tend to spike when there are serious economic, financial and geopolitical risks in the global economy. As we all are aware 2008 saw the peak of global financial crisis. It is a known fact that in World War II people were stocking their houses with Guns, canned food and gold bars.

Mrs. Beroz Vacha is the Founder Member and Honorary Director & Consultant of the Helen Keller Institute for Deaf & DeafBlind (HKIDBI), a Pioneer Institute for the education of Deafblind, not only in India but also South East Asia. This Institution was started in 1977 at Byculla in a Municipal School Building. The second unit was started in Navi Mumbai, the third at Mira Road and now a fourth Unit will start at Karjat.

In 1965, at the start of her career as a Teacher for Deaf she came across a young Deaf girl who had become Blind - her first contact with DeafBlind. Beroz says "Being with this girl who was so intelligent

and trapped by this severest of handicaps and yet undaunted in spirit — this attitude changed the entire course of my life."

She has been the beacon light and angel who has brought up HKIDBI with her tireless zeal and vigour since the last 36 years. In 2006 four DeafBlind students passed the SSC Examination without the help of a scribe. They accomplished this impossible goal with the help of computers. For Deaf & DeafBlind children language acquisition is restricted due to their hearing and vision impairment. They learn through touch with their fingers. Sign language, finger spelling, gestures is their mode of communication. They are taught Braille so that they can read and write.

For Vocation and Rehabilitation Training they are taught computer based education like screen & offset printing, Fine Arts, 3D Animations, Brails Press, making gift articles, etc. They also have a Printing Press which caters to orders

from outsiders. These are all income generating schemes.

Mrs. Beroz Vacha worked for the Movie "BLACK", which showcased to the world plight of DeafBlind.

She received scholarships to study, train and visit various institutions in UK, USA, Holland and Germany to study educational techniques for Deaf multiply and Deafblind children.

She has been bestowed 13 prestigious Awards, few of which are as under:

- International Ann Sullivan Medal in Sweden.

- Presidential National Award for the Best Institute of its kind by former President Ms. Pratibha Patil.

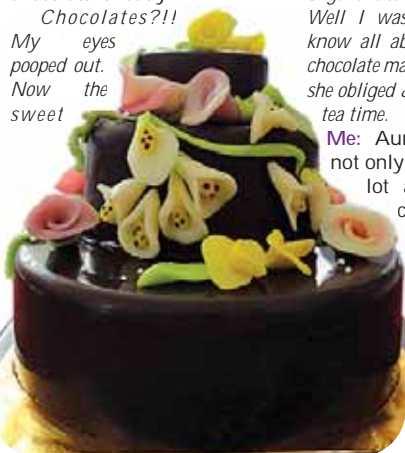

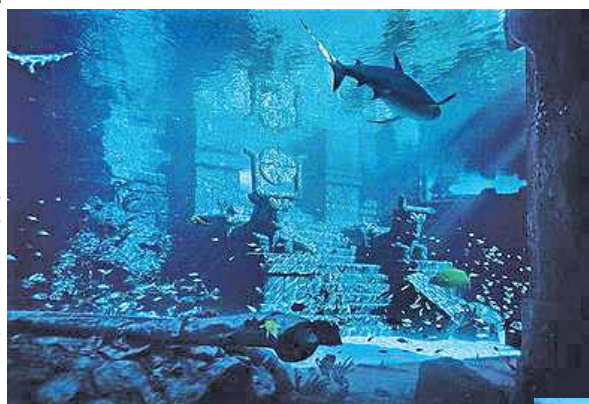

So there is a mad rush for gold and prices tend to push up exorbitantly. Also, gold performs best when there is a risk of high inflation, as its popularity as a store of value increases. I believe above two were the most important factors which led to gold prices soaring new highs over past several years.

So what are the factors contributing to down fall in gold? There may be many reasons for it. But most likely and proximate reason I could think is because speculators are selling it.

In recent years, speculation has been rampant, with

hedge funds, mutual funds, exchange-traded funds (E.T.F.s), and individual investors bidding the price up from \$600 an ounce in 2007 to a peak of \$1,920.30 in September, 2011. Now since the US economy is recovering and European crisis seem to settle down it is wise to dump gold for purchase of real assets. First four months of 2013 saw global equity markets rally with US markets trading at all time high and Nikkei of Japan at multi year highs. So there is a clear preference shift from gold to equities.

So what should we do now? Here the important thing to consider is the purpose

for which we hold gold. If the exposure to gold is for specific purpose like children marriage, than one can take advantage of price correction, but purely from investment perspective gold has very limited potential from here on and should not form more than 5% to 7% of the overall portfolio.

This is what Warren Buffet had quoted recently "Gold gets dug out of the ground in Africa, or someplace. Then we melt it down, dig another hole, bury it again and pay people to stand around guarding it. It has no utility. Anyone watching from Mars would be scratching their head."

can't be seen and It is nearly impossible to tell. The only way some can guess you have them is because your hair is so amazingly beautiful they just assume you must have some extensions.

"Does it harm the hair?"

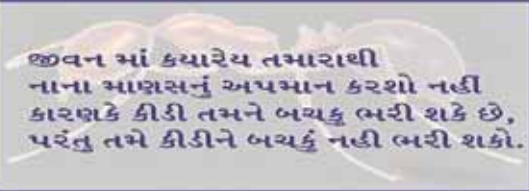

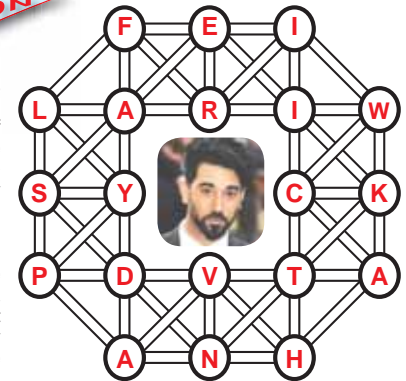
