### FROM THE EDITORS' DESK

Robert Frost inspires me every day. In my cabin I have amongst other things, a poem of his pasted on the wall in front of me. The Road not Taken... It is one of my favourite poems. The delightful rhymester Frost ends the simple piece with...

I shall be telling this with a sigh...somewhere ages and ages hence... two roads diverged in a wood and I... I took the one less travelled by ... and that has made all the difference.

Someone asked me the other day what my religious leanings were... I really sat back and thought about it... as an Editor of a public forum, my leaning is basically toward the truth and that's pretty much it. But as a religious Zoroastrian Parsi I don't think 'leaning' is just about what you proclaim yourself to be. I mean it's all well and good to shout 'I am orthodox' or 'I am reformist' but the truth is you will never know what your leaning is, until Ahura Mazda throws a test your way... until he presents you with a child who wishes to marry outside the Community, or a mother who wants to be cremated or a relative who comes all the way from USA to walk into the Atash Behram in shorts! Ideally leanings should be toward goodness, faithfulness, tolerance and acceptance. :)

On that note, I hope our nation also rethinks its intolerant stance and supports our LGBT Community. Why this inequality!?







Dinshaw asks other Trustees to make Token Sacrifices to match his and how much of the Trustees we will see at the event.... Parsi Times brings you the useful facts.

fter serious differences arose between the Trustees leading to postponement of the Congress it took serious diplomatic efforts by some senior persons of the Community to bring it back on track.

Four Trustees, Yazdi Desai, Khojeste Mistree, Arnavaz Mistry and Jimmy Mistry stood their ground and refused to be a part of the Congress where Dinshaw Mehta was the Chairman, as he was under investigation by the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) for alleged financial impropriety.

Under pressure from Zoroastrians across the world, the need to put the Congress back on track was felt by all involved. Dinshaw Mehta stated that 3 Trustees, Muncherji Cama, Armaity Tirandaz and himself had agreed to recuse themselves from the Congress proceedings. This turned out to be partially untrue as Muncherji Cama and Armaity

Tirandaz had not made any such statement.

After prolonged discussions Mehta agreed to step down from the Chairmanship of the Congress but insisted that as a face saving measure (for himself)

by all was that seven Trustees would attend

any official program 1( meaning none



them would be with the President of India during his visit) and every Trustee would be on the dais only once during the entire Congress when they were part of a panel.

Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla was requested to be the Chairman of the WZC and Mr. Nadir Godrej was requested to be the Vice-Chairman. Despite their busy schedules and prior commitments both agreed graciously and have also made the time to ensure the success of the event.

The last few weeks have seen a flurry of activity amongst the Trustees similar to what one sees at BPP election times. Pages and pages of paid advertisements making allegations, giving replies and justifications; all vituperative and vague. In all the smoke that has been generated the real fire is no longer visible. The issue was simple.

#### Did the Trust/Trustees receive any monies in cash? If yes – who took the money and where is it now?

four Trustees signed a new complaint and filed in with the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of the Mumbai Police.

Simple so far. But now it starts getting murky.

Mehta in his own inimitable style avoids answering the real questions. Instead he makes allegations against the Desais and the Mistrys. Personal vendetta and personal advancement are the motivation for this false complaint he shouts through pages and pages of paid advertisement. (On one particular Sunday he paid for and published 8 pages!!!). He talks about the attendance of the Trustees, the meeting outside the BPP toilet and the World Zoroastrian Congress. And he never addresses the real issue - was there a cash transaction as alleged or not?

The four Trustees fall for this ploy and start defending themselves.

### PT has a few questions for the Trustees.

For the four Trustees who have signed the final complaint:

- · Why are you focusing on Mehta's allegations instead of the basic issue?



rom the achievements of the largest of the ancient empires – which at its peak included for virtually half of the world's population at the time - to today, one of the world's smallest communities. The achievements of the Zoroastrian community are perhaps unmatched in

world history. From the Achaemenid Empire, to the British Raj, to modern India - Zoroastrians have been at the forefront of virtually every field they have put their hand to, wherever they have settled. Today, the Zoroastrian community maintains a level of influence that belies its tiny size.

This presentation attempts to analyse why this is the case. Whilst the Zoroastrians can draw strength from great works such as the Cyrus Cylinder - the world's first recognisable Bill of Rights - this submission will also argue that Zoroastrian achievement has comes from our ability to integrate into multiple communities whilst maintaining our identity. Zoroastrians have always been able to adapt to

changing circumstances, be they territorial, political or economic.

I will explain how this ability to adapt to changes in circumstances - something aided by Zoroastrianism's nonevangelising tradition - has allowed Parsis to remain at the forefront of public and political life in an unbroken thread of achievement from Cyrus the Great to the present day.



or the longest time I have wanted to sit across the table from Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla and understand what makes a man so magnanimous in his Work, his Charity and his personality. It was the sad twist of events within the offices of the Bombay Parsi Punchayat that finally

gave me a chance to escape to Pune to meet Dr. Poonawalla. But whatever the reason to meet him, I was determined to try and understand the man who would, at the end of this calendar year be addressing the starry eyed delegates of the World Zoroastrian Congress 2013. As you all know Dr. Poonawalla, Chairman of the Poonawalla Group

which includes Serum Institute (India's grandest export in the world of Pediatric Vaccines) has graciously accepted the Chairmanship of the World Zoroastrian Congress, 2013 to be held in Mumbai from the 27th to the 30th of December.

I drove into the vast heart of his business empire and was asked at the gate if I had come to meet 'Cyrus Baba', indication of how Dr. Poonawalla is dear to and down to earth with his security staff. If it were not for that first interaction with his polite staff, I would not have guessed that humility could be a quality of a man who built the classic and rich landscape of the office premises that I now walked through. Each wall was covered with memories on the race track and each corner served home to a delightful and tasteful piece of furniture.

But humility wasn't the only pleasant surprise... the second was humour! During our chat we touched upon what he would say in his address to the delegates. He mentioned a few jokes he had thought of interspersing into his poignant message and then said... the young boys may hate me for

it but the girls will admire me!

Turns out surprises are the flavor of the month! Hardly a month shy of the Congress, the racing season and the Turf Club elections had already been weighing down on the agenda for Dr. Poonawalla when his Sponsorship of the Congress led him down a completely new rabbit hole! He says, 'My initial interest to get involved in only the sponsoring of the World Zoroastrian Congress was evoked a few years ago when I was approached during the time of the last Congress. I therefore agreed that when the Congress came to Mumbai, my base city, I would like to be the Principal Sponsor.

There was no particular motive except to help the funding of the Congress. Sometimes organizers find it difficult to seek funds from so many people and so I decided to do my part.

I was expecting to just involve myself to the minimum in the Congress

Now the agenda bursting to the seams, I think out aloud... to

I asked how that is turning out so far and he sighs.

Well, the preparations are now back on track. All seven of the BPP Trustees have unanimously reposed faith in me to take decisions and take the programme forward and so I am doing that. Of course I took a few decisions and put a few things in place without fear or favour. We have called in one of the best in class event companies, Percept to handle the event and it seems like a good decision to lighten the burden of the managing committee. The process has had to be smoothed over.

If all goes as per plan, we expect that 1200 to 1400 delegates will be attending all the four days of the Event.

You can see that the Congress is on Dr. Poonawallas' mind all the time. Throughout the length of our chat he comes up with ideas, sweetly even asks for my suggestions, taking decisions and brewing things in his busy mind.

I grew up in the city that owns a great deal of its gorgeous cultural

façade to the Poonawalla family and I ask Dr. Poonawalla how much of 'him' and his persona are going to be at an event which right now is plagued by controversy. He speaks about how controversy should not affect anyones' decision to be at the WZC 2013 and that he has always managed to maintain a safe distance

from it all. 'But I suppose now the controversy affect me because I have to deal

with the different factions within the organization body!'

We continue a chat. Over green tea I get to see the latest version of the agenda. 'I would love to see more interaction with the audience on the agenda but the dye is already cast for panel type discussions. There are a huge number of subjects on the schedule and I hope that the audience gets to ask questions and interact,' he says.

Under all the glamour that is Dr. Poonawalla is a hard days' work filled with substance. This reflects in his agenda as the new face of the Congress as well. 'The Congress must be about subjects and topics that need change and less about being glamorous. Controversial issues have been left out. We have however made a lot of room for networking and interaction in the evenings and plus the tea lunch and coffee breaks.... This gives the delegates a pleasant space to interact in. I would have liked to add some meaningful site visits to the agenda as well.

A lot of people including myself would have wanted to discuss the two major issues that would have been of

maximum interest; that is alternative disposal of the dead and the issue of the fate of children who have had or want to have their Navjotes, but are born by Intermarried Parsi girls who have marryed outside. However as theses are extremely dividing issues, discussions on them have not been included in the Congress so that the occasion can remain pleasant and least acrimonious!'

There is a time and place for everything. The Congress should not be all work and no play and Dr. Poonawallas' eyes light up as he talks about the special event planned at the race course for all the Delegates. 'For the racing programme on the 29th



નહોતો; પુસ્તકો, પુસ્તકાલયો તથા એ દેશોની સંસ્કૃતિનો નાશ કરવાનો પ્રયાસ પણ તેણે નહોતો કર્યો.એક ઈશ્વરવાદમાં માનતા યહદીઓ પ્રત્યે તેને ખુબ

shavings and cherries.




