ZOROASTRIAN CHARITY FUNDS OF HONG KONG, CANTON &
MACAO AND WZO TRUST FUNDS COLLOBORATE TO PRESERVE
THE SANCTITY AND PRIVACY OF NAVSARI ATASHBEHRAM

Our Atashbehram at Navsari is one of the most important spiritual powerhouses that sustains and nurtures our community. After Iranshah Atashbehram was consecrated at Sanjan in the 10th century CE, the Navsari Atashbehram was consecrated after a gap of about 800 years. At that time as there were no records about how an Atashbehram could be consecrated, the learned Dasturs of Navsari formulated a scheme from various scriptural texts & consecrated the 2nd Atashbehram of India in 1765 CE. The subsequent three Shehenshahi Atashbehrams, namely Modi Atashbehram of Surat (1823 CE), Wadiaji Atashbehram of Mumbai (1830 CE) and Anjuman Atashbehram of Mumbai (1897 CE), were all consecrated in the light of the Scheme prepared at the time of consecrating the Navsari Atashbehram.

Various religious ceremonies are performed at Navsari Atashbehram, which by religious injunction cannot be viewed by individuals who are not Zoroastrians. In late 2018, we learnt from reliable sources that the building of a Zoroastrian family opposite our Navsari Atashbehram (House No. 635 in Ward No.8 known as Bacha Dhanji House) was going to be sold and the same purchased by a non-Zoroastrian family, from where the main hall of Atashbehram could be seen clearly, where jashan & other religious ceremonies are being regularly performed. Even our Dadgah building could also be seen clearly from the building. This was clearly an unacceptable situation, as it would have meant compromising the sanctity of our revered Atashbehram.

Since the question of preserving the sanctity and privacy of our Atashbehram was of paramount importance it had become essential that the building be purchased only by a Zoroastrian individual or entity. Considering the sanctity of the Atashbehram would be compromised the owners of the property, though offered Rs.100,00,000 by the non-Zoroastrian buyer, were willing to sell it to for Rs.77,00,000/- only to any Zoroastrian. With registration and stamp duty expected to be additional, the amount required was a total of Rs.80,00,000/-, an amount that only someone having not only financial means but also large hearts that had concern for the community's religious institutions, could undertake such a mammoth task at short notice.

Divinity is known to work in mysterious ways, and it was nothing short of divine intervention that brought Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao on to the scene due to the efforts of WZO Trust Funds. Faced with this dilemma, we contacted Mr. Dinshaw Tamboly, Chairman of WZO Trust Funds to assist us in our mission and he readily agreed to do so. He contacted the Trustees of Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao with a request that they consider supporting this project. It is to the credit of the Trustees of Trustees of Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao that they considered the request and approved to give a donation to WZO Trust Funds to enable them to purchase the building.

WZO Trust Funds have agreed to enter into an arrangement with Navsari Atashbehram & Vadi Daremeher Trust Fund to manage and maintain the building for which a token compensation of Rs.1,000/— per annum will be paid to them. Navsari Atashbehram & Vadi Daremeher Trust Fund will maintain the building in pristine condition, and pay the annual rates, taxes, and all statutory charges. Under the arrangement, Navsari Atashbehram & Vadi Daremeher Trust Fund shall be entitled to use the said property for various Atashbehram related issues such as providing accommodation to Mobeds, providing guest house facilities to families of young boys from Athronan Families who are to be initiated as Navar/ Maratab, Zoroastrian pilgrims and so on.

We, Trustees of Navsari Atashbehram & Vadi Daremeher Trust Fund profusely thank Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao for their generosity, the Trustees and members of the Navsari Local Committee of WZO Trust Funds for their guidance, especially their Chairman Mr. Dinshaw Tamboly for having used his good offices to quickly steer the project to its quick and satisfactory conclusion. It was indeed the Blessings of Ahura Mazda that made the Trustees of Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao, and the Trustees and members of the Navsari LocalCommittee of WZO Trust Funds, to collaborate and put in collective efforts on account of which to the sanctity and privacy of our beloved Atashbehram has been preserved.

May the Divine Light of our Atashbehram always continue to shine bright, guide us all, Bless Trustees of Zoroastrian Charity Funds of Hong Kong, Canton & Macao and the Trustees of WZO Trust Funds with good health and prosperity in the service of our community.

Rashne Yasht. the Zarathushtra is said to have asked Ahura Mazda, "What of the Holy Word is created true?....Ahura Mazda answered, "The most glorious Holy Word is created true, that which is created progress making, that which is fit to discern, that which is healthful, wise and happy, that which is more powerful to destroy, than all other creatures."- Excerpt from 'Zoroastrianism - An Ethnic Perspective' by Khojeste Mistree Indeed!

In our growing years we are taught, nay forced to perform our kusti, go to the Agiary and Atashbehram on auspicious days and pray to a God we cannot see, in a language we do not understand! Very often the vouthful mind questions the logic of ritualistic prayer. Based on my own journey and experience from not wearing the sadra-kusti to spending two hours every day for my prayers, I share with you the essence of my learning...

So, here is a challenge, to the youth of my beloved community to test the efficacy of our prayers. I will not start

with long prayers but request your attention to these 8 names of Dadar Ahura Mazda (in celebration of 8 years of Parsi Times!) The meanings of these are given hereunder and it is my ardent request that you recite just these 8 names for all of the next week. If you do not find any benefit, then please do write in an admonishment. However, if you feel that these words (manthras) have worked, then I urge you to continue to use these in your daily life:

Ya Harvespa Tavan: (I) reciting this name increases strength.

(II) Ya Farakhtantehe: reciting this name can cure eye ailments (we all suffer from tired eyes due to mobile usage all day long).

Ya Adaro: reciting this name gives us the direction to walk on the right path and helps us surmount any obstacles.

Ya Safna: reciting this name showers us with progress (for advancement in work, finances, etc).

Ya Nasha: is one who is upright and honest and reciting this name It helps us overcome bad habits and walk the right path.

Ya Anaaynahe: is the creator of beauty and reciting this name helps invoke aesthetic benefits for for those who wish to enhance their looks. Ya Beshtarna: reciting

this name removes difficulties

and can be invoked for good health.

(VIII) Ya Adar Kibaritatoom: reciting this name changes a rock-like person into a gemlike one - basically it helps

transform your mindset and outlook. Reciting this name is especially beneficial for students who have difficulties in studying.

Please Note: These names should be recited at least 9 times each, after doing your kusti.

And remember always - the seed of prayer sown today will help you grow into your highest and best self.


he old phrase, 'man's best friend', may need to change to be more inclusive! A study carried out by Purina Dog Food revealed

Aapro Cyrus Broacha, the Brand Ambassador of Humour, is back with his monthly column, with 'Noble' recommendations for the Election Commission!!


y friend, Nariman the Noble, (okay his name is Nariman Noble, but because he's so full of himself, his well-wishers, which



nen Dr. Strange utters 'We're in the endgame now', in the closing stages of Infinity War (2018), it's possible that a few viewers would have guessed the title of this, the 22nd in the series. Directors Anthony and Joe Russo along with previous collaborators, have attempted a closure of sorts in this three-hour epic. The backstory is simple - the evil Thanos (Josh Brolin), with the aid of the six Infinity Stones, has decimated half of the galaxy's population in Infinity War, including some of the Avengers. Among the survivors who vowed to bring an end to Thanos's fingersnapping tyrannical powers, are Iron Man (Robert Downey Jr), Black Widow - Natasha (Scarlett Johansson), (Chris Hemsworth), Thor

Captain America (Chris Evans), Rocket Racoon (voiced by Bradley Cooper) and Hulk (Mark Ruffalo). There are few surprises here - those who've seen Infinity War would instantly connect to Endgame, the film indulging the fans well with the time-and-space travel segments. After all, the Marvel Cinematic Universe franchise has relied heavily upon fan loyalty though in super-hero flicks a lot seems recycled and would be seen through the 3-D glasses as deja vu. Of all the actors, Robert Downey Jr. gets the most screentime and he utilises it well. More than an hour is spent building relationships before the Russos get down to the superheroes saving universe. In Endgame, the end, by and large, justifies




