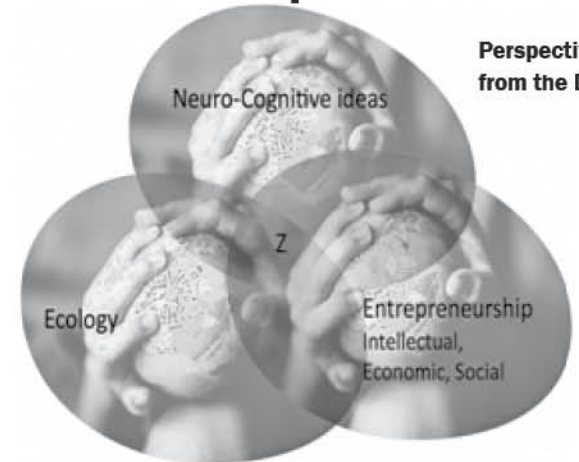

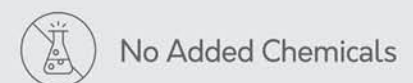

Issues Of Concern

Service Charges, Dokhmenashini And The BPP

THE REFUND OF SERVICE CHARGES...

A few weeks ago, in my address to community members, particularly those staying in BPP baugs, I had reported my suggestion to the Board, as regards the Service Charges issue. I had reiterated, that since the community members, who had not paid the Service Charges had been allowed to pay the rent arrears by the Board of Trustees, then it was only fair, that those who have genuinely and meticulously paid their dues, over a period of 43 months, should also be treated on par.

My suggestion to the Board was that, given the paucity of funds, as far as the BPP is concerned, half the amount or part thereof, be refunded to the beneficiaries of the Trust; and the balance amount be adjusted against future rents, service charges, licences payable, etc.

It is crucial to address this important issue immediately, given the huge financial problems being faced by many community members facing pay cuts, losses of jobs and small businesses winding down, etc. Despite my repeated attempts to discuss and resolve this prime community grievance, unfortunately, my colleague Trustees have not deemed it fit to give this issue the importance it deserves and address its pros and cons towards a fair and equitable decision.

The Service Charges injustice has languished on the agenda. Last Tuesday, I tried raising this issue yet again with my colleagues in the Board meeting. Sadly, my colleague Trustee - Viraf Mehta continues to sabotage any attempt I make to have an informed, rational and open discussion on this issue.

Till date, I have initiated the

discussion twice, but Viraf launches into oblique personal attacks, insults, distorted facts and a loud monologue, which prevents any other Trustee from sharing his or her opinions. This has prevented any meaningful discussion from taking place, and I admit I am not in a position to share the views of my colleagues - Armaity Tirandaz, Noshir Dadrawala or Xerxes Dastur, simply because they haven't been given the respect or opportunity to get a word in edgewise!

Despite the rubbish and lies being written about this issue in the Parsi Junction, I genuinely believe, that legally, morally and ethically, the amounts that have been paid by the sincere community members, who have trusted the BPP, should be refunded.

The whole drama that is being played out, where lip-service is being given to "recovery" of these pending dues from the wilful defaulters, is nothing but a sham meant to protect the few individuals who have lent their support to Viraf Mehta and his father.

I IMPLORE MY COLLEAGUE TRUSTEES TO TAKE UP THIS MOST UNJUST ISSUE, SO WE CAN DECIDE UPON AND ARRANGE TO PAY BACK THESE AMOUNTS, IN INSTALMENTS IF NECESSARY, OR THEN, TAKE LEGAL ACTION AGAINST THE WILFUL DEFAULTERS WITHIN A FORTNIGHT, HEREOF.

In the next Board meeting, I intend to once again raise this issue, and given the public display of my angst and concern, I'm reasonably confident that my so-far silenced colleagues, will now speak up and there will be a meaningful exchange of ideas and discussion on the legal position, and the way forward.

I hope and pray that in my next communication with the readers of PT, there will be some good news, particularly for those community members, who have been rendered jobless or have had to bear massive pay-cuts, or even non-payment of salaries.

DOONGERWADI, ARAMGARH AND LIES...

Last week I received a call from a friend who informed me that the

ghost-writer editor of Parsi Junction - Dinshaw Mehta, has claimed that I have proposed an Aaramgarh at Doongerwadi!

Nothing could be further from the truth! The facts are as follows...

Dasturji Khurshed Dastoor, High Priest of Iranshah - Udvada, speaking on behalf of the Udvada priests, had earlier shared an article in Parsi Times, expressing his concern, as well as the collective concerns of the other Udvada Dasturjis, as regards the current practice of the mandated cremation of all people who succumb to Covid-19.

Dasturji Khurshed expressed angst and abhorrence, in equal measure, at even the idea of any priest being cremated, should he fall victim to the coronavirus. Dasturji then called up BPP Chairperson Armaity Tirandaz, not once, but twice, asking her to discuss this major concern in the BPP meeting, about the way forward.

When Dasturji joined the Trustees on a Zoom call, he expressly reiterated his and his colleagues' strong commitment to the system of Dokhmenashini. On behalf of the priests, the laity and the entire community, he expressed his deep-rooted concern about the cremation of community members who passed away due to Covid.

Dasturji pointed out that in almost every Indian state, there are Aaramgarhs (burial grounds) for the community. He informed the Trustees that the Udvada priests had taken the decision that if any of them or their family members should unfortunately pass away as a covid victim, they would not go to the crematorium, but would rather go to the new Aaramgarh, which is being set up in Valsad District.

Dasturji further suggested that BPP convene a joint meeting of all the Vada Dasturjis and some religious scholars, to see if a way forward can be found, to continue with the system of Dokhmenashini and to elicit the views of the others, regarding whether the Aaramgarh would be preferred to the crematorium.

In this meeting, after a detailed and meaningful discussion with the Trustees, the Vada Dasturjis, Dasturjis and religious scholars announced their desire to have an offline meeting

amongst themselves, which also took place. A note has been sent by them recommending that the Trustees make further efforts to see, that those who passed away from Covid, can be consigned to the Dokhmas.

The trustees are, in fact, discussing the way forward and contemplating approaching the authorities as well as moving the courts, if so advised.

FINALLY...

It is indeed a sad state of affairs that my colleague Trustee, Viraf Mehta, passes on all the BPP information, every internal BPP email, every little scrap of paper, to his father, Dinshaw Mehta, who then misuses it to publish rubbish, and twists and manipulates the facts, and blatantly lies to promote his son as well as to attack me, out of his personally-stated fear, that I would be the next Chairman!

Such ridiculous political agendas need to stop and the welfare of the community has to take precedence. Whenever I have discussed with Viraf his father's dishonest writings, he has always claimed that he does not read the Parsi Junction! However, recent issues openly belie this claim.

It was absurd and pathetic to capitalize on the news of having six of our pall-bearers vaccinated, and use this to elicit the headline proclaiming: 'Congratulations Viraf Mehta', written by his father!! Such childish promotional tactics of the son (Viraf) by his father (Dinshaw), diminishes the dignity of both - the august institution of BPP as well as its Trustee, and further substitutes respectability with ridicule.

I take this opportunity to ask Viraf Mehta to come and work collectively with the other Trustees as one unit, as a BPP Trustee of his own individual standing, and not play the messenger and enabler to his father Dinshaw, who seems tragically and clinically addicted to political power-play in the community. Moving out from under his father's shadow will make the sun shine brighter for the community!

As Trustees, we need to realise that instead of scoring brownie points over each other, we need to come together and work collectively, now more than ever - as our community faces one of its most critical periods, in its recent history.

WAPIZ Provides Life-Saving Oxygen Concentrators To 16 Baugs And Colonies

In today's critical times, when our miniscule community is battling the deadly Coronavirus, we hear tragic news daily of someone's loved one passing away due to either lack of timely treatment or lack of availability of hospital beds or worse still, a lack of Oxygen.

come up with a project that will literally save lives of our community members. The Project envisaged providing at least one Oxygen concentrator to each of our Baugs and Colonies, for the use of its residents, when urgently needed.

Every day, the media has been lamenting the loss of lives due to the acute shortage of Oxygen. Oxygen Concentrators are in acute short supply and also very costly. With each concentrator being sold for over Rs. 60,000 to Rs. 80,000 and upwards, it is near impossible for a middle-class family to purchase. At some places, concentrators are being given on rent for Rs. 10,000/- a day, which is also a very prohibitive cost. What's even more scary, is that many of the Oxygen Concentrators available in the market are of questionable quality.



Constantly looking out for the welfare of the community, WAPIZ, under the leadership of its CEO and community service stalwart - Anahita Desai, has

Hence, a lot of research was necessary, various vendors had to be contacted and reliability

of the concentrators was checked by consulting doctors. After due diligence, the OXY-MED Oxygen concentrator, a 5LPM which gives 90 +3 oxygen output and weighs 16.5 kgs, was chosen by the WAPIZ team. This is a medical grade concentrator, with its parts made in Germany and Italy. This is also the only concentrator which comes with a 3-year warranty. Because of its unique specifications, it is very difficult to procure these machines.

A young couple, known for their staunch commitment to community service, Karyesh and Sherry Patel put in long days of hard work to first research and identify the right concentrator, and then transport these to Mumbai. They were instrumental also in bringing in donations for buying the concentrators and finally delivering them to 16 colonies all over Mumbai.

WAPIZ has already delivered one Oxygen Concentrator each, to the respective organisations of each of the below mentioned baugs and colonies:

1. Cusrow Baug
2. Khareghat Colony
3. Godrej Baug
4. Rustom Baug

This project was possible due to the generous donations received from individuals, Trusts and Corporations. Magnanimous WAPIZ Trustee - Khojeste Mistree and his wife Firoza, helped in a big way to raise funds. WAPIZ Trustee - Meher Panthaki and Burges Wania also contributed largely to the success of this project.

Without Karyesh and Sherry Patel this project would not have been possible. They were responsible for putting in days of efforts on research to identify the best concentrators, getting them to Mumbai, bringing donations for this project and finally delivering it to 16 colonies all over Mumbai.

Ardaseer Wadia's Contributions Recognized By English Heritage

The plaque is part of a series in which English Heritage endeavours to promote the under-recognised historical contributions to Britain, of people from diverse communities - by marking the houses where they have lived, as hundreds of white historical figures have already been.

Dr. Mazda - Dahanu's Flying Doctor, Takes His Final Flight



The morning of 27th May, 2021, marked the unfortunate passing of 62-year-old Dr. Behramshah Mazda, one of Dahanu's most popular and cherished residents, famous as the 'Flying Doctor' in keeping with his weekly, Sunday-morning ritual of flying his ultra-light aircraft across the Dahanu-Gholvad shores. He passed away at the Mumbai Hospital after he had tested positive for Covid. He is survived by his loving wife - Roxana and their much-loved pet pug.

Equipped with an MBBS degree from the Government Medical College, Solapur, Dr. Mazda dedicated his life to serving patients across the coastal town at his clinic on Dahanu's Irani Road. He attended to the ailing - many of them adivasis from surrounding areas - seven days a week from his clinic as also from his home - Moti Manzil, his ancestral bungalow, just a few minutes from his clinic. Or he would be consulting patients via the telephone. While he charged a nominal fee, treatment for the underprivileged was free.

Till a couple of years ago, he nurtured his passion for flying, with a self-owned ultra-

light aircraft, which resembled a tricycle with hang-glider-like wings and two tiny seat, and with which he glided into the Dahanu skies with, every Sunday morning at 7:00 am! He sold it off after four decades, due to issues of maintenance and various protocols.

Throughout his career, Dr. Mazda cured and saved thousands of lives, and he continued to do so through the pandemic. As per a news report in Mid-day, the adivasis from Palghar district, where Dahanu, shared during a recent on-ground reported series, that getting to a health centre meant walking miles. Containment Zone was an unheard phrase, and because they didn't know better, corpses of covid victims were brought back to the village for a full-blown funeral, in complete violation of Covid-19 protocol. They had little to no awareness about the deadly pandemic. It was then, that practitioners like Dr. Mazda saved the day, to hold up rural and semi-urban India's crumbling healthcare infrastructure.

The community stands in solidarity, by his wife and family. May his noble and kind soul attain Garothman Behest!

death due to Covid, the company will bear all the expenses of their children's education till graduation in India. "The Company has always been a shield of steel, supporting its stakeholders at all times. This time is no different. 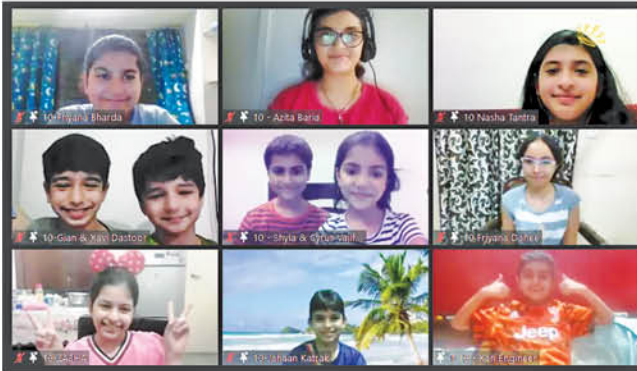

HPY 2021 Goes Online!



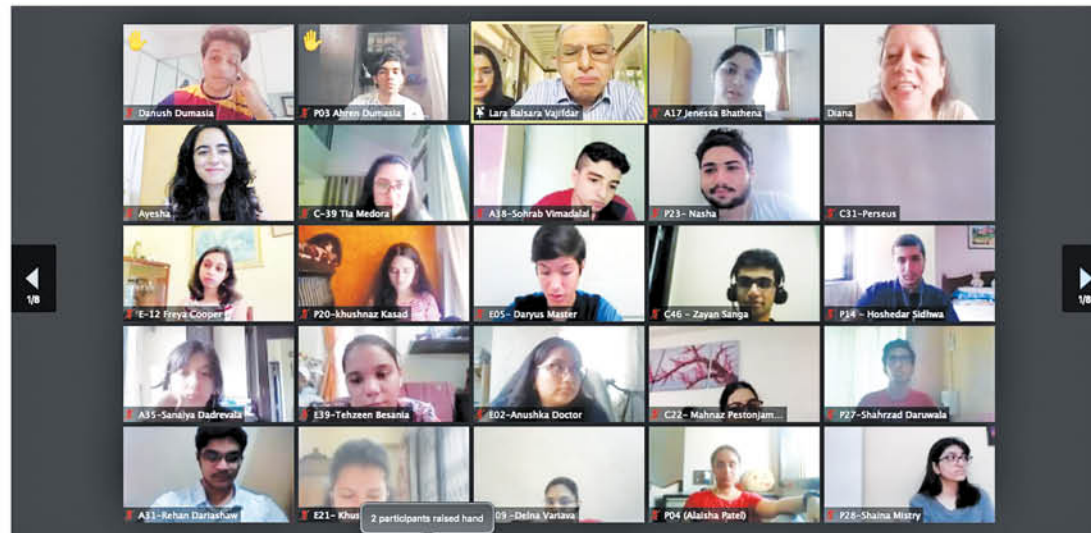

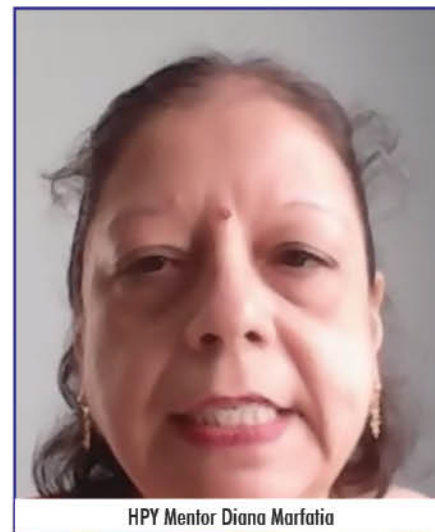

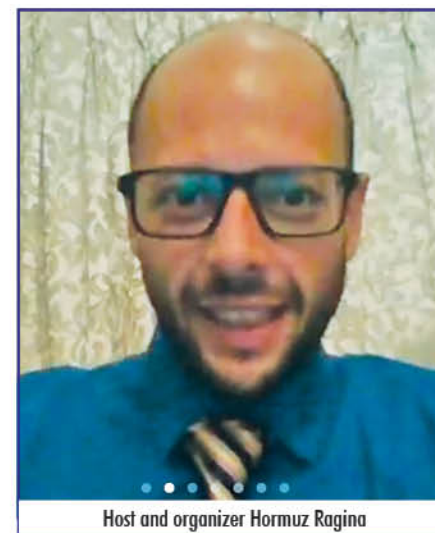

Appeal By F S Parukh Dharamshalla

The F. S. Parukh Dharamshalla, a home for the aged and a much-needed initiative of the BPP, situated at Khareghat Colony, Hughes Road, is a boon for the senior citizens of our community. 90% of the residents here reside totally free of cost, with all requirements catered including accommodation, meals, clothes, linen, diapers, toiletries, laundry services, services of barber, etc. Medications prescribed by Doctors, specially appointed to take care of the Dharamshalla's senior citizens, are also supplied free of cost, as is medical equipment like wheelchairs, walkers, surgical beds, side-tables; and hospitalization, if required (at the BD Petit Parsee General Hospital).

Many senior residents need constant supervision and help with basic tasks like bathing and usage of the toilet. Some are immobile and restricted to their beds. The Dharamshalla's capacity houses about 100 residents, of which some are Paying Residents and are provided a separate room in addition to all the mentioned facilities, at a nominal monthly cost of Rs. 7,000/- (not inclusive of care-taker/ward-boy/ ayah expenses). Television sets in each ward are installed for the entertainment of the residents and monthly entertainment programmes are also organized to keep up their spirits.

Residents are housed in two separate wings for men and women. Maintenance and hygiene also levies a huge expense for the upkeep as well as repairs and maintenance of two lifts, furniture, fixtures, electricity bills and appliances, etc. Huge funds are needed for smooth and efficient functioning of a Home of this magnitude, including the salaries of staff, includes a Doctor, nurses, Manager, Assistant Manager, Supervisor, Cooks, Ayahs, Ward boys, liftman, etc. The residents are provided wholesome, nutritious meals. Some meals are sponsored by our donors.

All the above facilities are taken care of with the support of BPP and generous donors. A Ladies Advisory Committee looks after the needs of the residents and oversees the running of the Dharamshalla. The Committee members, Managers and support staff ensure that the sunset years of residents are their 'golden years', spent with respect, dignity and caring.

The Vispa Humata Prayer

Prayer forms the mainstay of our Mazdayasni Zarathushti religion and reciting the 'Vispa Humata' prayer blesses our lives with good health, wisdom, abundance and joy. In the Avestan language, 'Vispa' means 'all'.

The Vispa Humata prayer is composed of simple words of the Avestan language, which help us comprehend it easily. The verbatim English translation would be, "All good thoughts, All good words, All good deeds I do willingly. All evil thoughts, all evil words, all evil deeds I do unwillingly. All good thoughts, All good words, All good deeds will take my soul to Paradise. All evil thoughts, all evil words, all evil deeds will take my soul to Hell."

All good thoughts, good words, good deeds are the identification of the Ashavans (or holy people) for Paradise. The word 'Ashavan' is broken down as - 'Asho' meaning righteous and holy; and 'Van' meaning person.

The Vispa Humata is to be prayed after praying the Khorshed and Meher Nyaish. It is one of the 'Farazyat'



(obligatory) prayers which one should pray to start the new day, with salutation and prayer (Bandagi) devoted to Ahura Mazda. After the Kusti ritual, it is mandatory to pray Jasa Me Avanghe Mazda, the Sarosh Baj, including the complete Havan Geh, Khorshed and Meher Nyaish and thereafter one should pray a very potent prayer 'Vispa Humakhta' thrice.

The Khorshed and Meher Nyaish and Vispa Humakhta can be prayed in the Havan Geh, Rapithwin Geh, or the Biji Havan Geh, and the Uzerin Geh because there is sunlight during these three Gehs. It is most important to recite our 'Farazyat' prayers in the Havan Geh to ensure that we remain immune to the evil forces of 'Dushmata, Duzukhta, Duzuvarashta'. Applying our prayers in all aspects of our

daily life enables us to achieve Vahishtem Ashum, leading a righteous Zoroastrian life of wisdom, honesty, integrity and compassion. Wisdom is most important for us to understand when any evil form is trying to entice or trap us. This is how our soul is escorted to the best existence which is Garothman.

'Humata, Hukhta, Hvarashta' means 'Good Thoughts, Good Words, Good Deeds'. 'Manashni, Gavashni, Kunashni' are verbal nouns which signify our actions of 'Thinking only Humata (Good Thoughts), Speaking only Hukhta (Good Words), and Performing only Hvarashta (Good Deeds).' Only by imbibing the Divine Energies of the Universe, can we achieve lasting happiness in our human form and ensure a place in Garothman for our souls, after mortality ceases.
