#### A Full Board Of Trustees -The Need OF The Hour!

# Freshtohome To Scale Omnichannel, Overseas Presence

he pandemic accelerated a fundamental change in consumer behaviour, as they turned online. The start-up delivers nearly 2 million orders every month!

FreshToHome, a Bengaluru-

based meat, fish and fresh produce e-tailer, plans to scale up its omnichannel presence, expand across its core market India and West Asia, while focusing on deeper supply chain integration in these markets. Currently present in about 28 cities including metros, FreshToHome delivers nearly 2 million orders every month and looks to expand to 56 cities in the next 12 months... increasing from currentcount of 14 physical stores to 100. It currently sells 25,000 tonnes of produce yearly and 8 million litres of milk. Meat and fish constitute 70% of its product portfolio, having entered the fresh fruits & vegetables category in 2019.

Last year, FreshToHome closed a \$121 million Series C funding round led by Investment Corporation of Dubai



(ICD) - the principal investment arm of the Government of Dubai, Investcorp and Ascent Capital, DFC, the Allana Group and other investors. "Offline presence and the whole touch and feel experience is important and lends a personal touch. Our offline expansion will be a combination of both standalone as well as multi-branded stores. The second wave was harsh but unlike the first, we were operationally ready," said Shan Kadavil, Co-founder & CEO, FreshToHome.



FreshToHome, which was founded in 2015 by Shan Kadavil and Mathew Joseph, competes with BigBasket, Licious as well as smaller startups. It is the largest player in the business in the UAE and now plans to expand to all GCC (Gulf Cooperation Council) countries.

"Our ready-to-cook and ready-to-eat products comprise a sizeable portion of our offering now. We also plan to launch a completely clean label (without preservatives) in 3-6 months, where we will sell cold cuts and burger patty," Kadavil said. In UAE, the company also offers meatless chicken, mince, and meatballs in the plant-based product category. "We are doing some R&D on that front and experimenting with meatless products for India as well," he added.

The pandemic helped accelerate online purchasing of meat products as consumers took to branded packaged items and companies improved their supplies and access to the market. A report by RedSeer earlier this year said urban Indian shoppers are increasingly taking to buying meat online, largely driven by the assurance of safety and hygiene, availability of various products under one umbrella, doorstep service provided by online meat providers. This led to a two-fold jump in gross merchandise value reported by online meat players as mapped by RedSeer during January-December last year. In 2020, online meat players saw a 10-15% jump in average revenue per user and reported a 10-15% improvement in customer retention.

Speaking about his journey with ZCBL, Yazdi shares, "I was invited to join the Board of Zoroastrian Bank by the then Chairman in late 2005. I rose to being elected as the Vice Chairman in 2011 and ten years later, in March 2021, I was elected as the Chairman by the existing Board."

"Zoroastrian Bank is a 94-year-old institution. # Iran Seeks UNESCO Status For Meheregan Fest

eheregan, the largest Iranian festival after Noruz, dates back to ancient times when the start of autumn brought the start of the new year. Iran's Research Institute of Cultural Heritage and Tourism is developing a dossier for the possible inscription of Mehregan on the UNESCO World Heritage list. The Persian festival marks friendship, affection, and love. Mehregan is planned to be inscribed jointly with Tajikistan, since it is currently performed among Zoroastrian communities in Iran and the people of Tajikistan, quoted an official earlier this week.

Marking the autumnal equinox, when day and night are equal, Meheregan brings together clusters of Iranian Zoroastrians in celebration of Mithra - the ancient Goddess of Friendship, Affection and Love. The celebrations are usually opened up with keynote speeches by Zoroastrian religious figures and officials, followed by Shahnameh recitations, contests and other joyful customaries.

A key feature for the event is large spreads in purple, laden with various ingredients, dishes, and elements each on behalf of a particular belief. Fruits, vegetables, dried nuts, sweets, rosewater, grilled lamb meat, lotus seeds, and silver coins, and a scale are typically placed, the latter symbolizes




autumnal equinox.

Mehregan falls on the 196th day of the Iranian calendar, which usually equals October 2 in the Gregorian calendar. The festivity used to be a traditional autumn harvest festival with several accounts of its origins. During the Achaemenid era (c. 550-330 BC), Mehregan was observed in an extravagant style in Persepolis at a time for harvest when taxes were collected. Avestan texts divide the Iranian year into two equal parts or seasons - summer and winter.

According to legend, Mehregan was a day of victory for Fereydoon and Kaveh, who overcame Zahak. They imprisoned him in Mount Damavand where he later died of his wounds. After the capture of Zahak, Fereydoon was nominated as the king and the people celebrate this occasion with great fervor. The story has been narrated in Shahnameh, the epic poem written by the illustrated Persian poet Ferdowsi (940-1020 CE).

# **Apex Court Issues Notices** On Alleged Ostracization Of **Inter-Married Parsi Women**



n 27th August, 2021, the Supreme Court issued notices to the Centre and others on a petition challenging the alleged discrimination and ostracization of Parsi women, who marry outside the community, as per media reports. The petitioners - a minor named Rian R. Kishnani and his mother - Sanayaa Dalal - have alleged that women marrying non-Parsis, and their offspring, are not allowed to participate in the community's religious, social and other activities, besides being derided on social media.

The bench comprising Justices Abdul Nazeer and AS Bopanna sought the response of the Centre and the Parsee Central Association Co-operative Housing Society Ltd., after it heard that such discrimination was a violation of Articles 14 (Right to Equality) and 21 (Life and Personal Liberty) of the Constitution; and that Parsi men marrying outside the community were not subjected to such discrimination or harassment.

The petitioners sought that the apex court give directions for the Declaration of any discrimination against the petitioners on grounds of race, ethnicity or parentage as unconstitutional; A directive to community leaders to ensure no discrimination is done against the petitioners on communal or racial grounds, and that they are not excluded from the Parsi community and society; The deletion of social media posts by two groups of orthodox Parsis, that are racist and insulting. The petitioners alleged that these posts targeted intermarried Parsi women and their children,

as well as all non-Parsis in general.

As per the petition, "The petitioners' fundamental rights are circumvented because they face social and religious ostracization, owing solely to factors of lineage, ethnicity and race consequential to the fact that Petitioner No 2 (Sanavaa Dalal) is married to a man considered to be a non-Parsi... Parsis are a race and ethnic group, and ostracization of a Parsi Zoroastrian and her offspring, on the ground of her marriage to an individual of a different lineage, race or religion, is contrary to basic human rights and the fundamental rights guaranteed by the Constitution of India."

The petition, filed through advocate Jasmine Damkewala, contended that marriage being a personal choice, women should be free to exercise it without having to face ostracization. It was submitted that a section of Parsis believes that the community is racially superior being of Aryan descent and insist that intermarriage of Parsis with other races "dilutes" and "contaminates" the ethnicity of the Parsis.

"This is contrary to the human rights of young impressionable children who are victimised simply because their mother is a Parsi but did not marry a Parsi. While some also discriminate against children born of inter-community marriages where the father is a Parsi married to a non-Parsi, the discrimination is prevalent and accepted as the norm where the child's mother is a Parsi but not the father," the petition said.

Adi Godrej is an alumnus of the Sloan School of Management at MIT, from where he received his Bachelor's and Master's degrees. 





# Worli Prayer Hall Completes 6 Years **In Service Of The Community**



n 1st September, 2021, (Roj Sarosh, Mah Farvardin), the Prayer Hall located at Worli in Mumbai completed six years in the service of providing facilities and prayers for the last rites of deceased community members. A Jashan commemorating the occasion was performed at 11:00 am, by Worli Prayer Hall coordinator - Er. Framroze Mirza along with Er. Adil Navdar.

Parsi Times caught up with Dinshaw Tamboly who has been instrumental in the establishment of the Worli Prayer Hall, which has been a much-needed option for those who wanted to opt for an alternative means of performing the last rites of their dearly departed. The Worli Prayer Hall has proven to be especially beneficial to the community, in keeping with the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic, where those succumbing to the virus were not allowed the traditional last rites, in keeping with the safety protocol mandated by the State Government. From its inception to date, the Worli Prayer Hall has serviced over 600 funerals.

PT: Could you share with us the genesis of the Prayer Hall and the ideology behind its establishment for Parsis who wished for an alternative choice of funeral rites for their dearly departed?

Dinshaw Tamboly: From the early 1980's, we were faced with the reality of vultures fast vanishing from the Indian skies, to never return. India lost over 97% of its original vulture population before the turn of the last century. This was something that had never been contemplated earlier by residents of this city; and several community members began questioning the functioning of the dokhmas and started opting for the cremation of family members.

The problem was the state of public crematoria and the absence of a place where prayers could be carried out in peaceful surroundings, over the first 4 days of a person's passing. The need was felt for a Prayer Hall where Parsi/Irani Zoroastrians, who opted for cremation, could be assured of obsequies being carried out over the first 4 days, which the majority of Zoroastrians consider very important.

The late Mr. Jamsheed Kanga, the then Municipal Commissioner of Mumbai, made several attempts to locate such a place, as did several other groups of individuals including the Association for Revival of Zoroastrianism. Mr. Kanga persevered well after he retired as Commissioner, to continue the guest for a Prayer Hall. Thanks to the high regard his successors had for him, the MCGM agreed, around 2009, to allot a plot of land where a Prayer Hall could be constructed within the Worli Crematorium complex, at the community's cost, but in which Zoroastrians would have priority of use at the times when our prayers are normally held.



believe community should be thankful to those who helped founded this establishment and services for having taken so much effort in securing the funds and various permissions. and providing these alternative funeral services, which came to be of crucial help throughout the Covid outbreak, and

continues to be so. My colleagues and I have been dedicated and committed full-time, to performing the last rites and prayers, for all the Covid victims, at a time when not many others are being as accommodating. Of course, we ensure that all precautions are strictly followed and protocol is adhered to. We are able to provide these services only because of the presence of this Prayer Hall - we ensure that all prayers are performed for those who have passed away, including the 4-day prayers post the passing. We try and do our best to ensure the peace and divinely progress for the Ruvaan of the deceased. That is what matters to us,

The establishment of the Prayer Hall has been the result of cohesive teamwork of many, but the main credit goes to two mentors - Jamsheed Kanga and Homi Khusrokhan, who worked tirelessly to build and commission the facility.

I have always believed that there should be dignity in death. During my stint as a BPP trustee, I had advocated to my fellow Trustees that the bunglis at Doongerwadi be made available for recitation of the four days prayers for those who opted for alternate funeral modes. This was not found acceptable.

Having always held that the departed should be given a dignified farewell and being a believer in the efficacy of our prayers, especially the first four days obsequies which were denied to those opting for cremation, I felt a great injustice being done to families who had opted for alternate modes of disposal. I therefore, readily participated in establishing the Prayer Hall at Worli, from where, those opting for cremation would be accorded a dignified farewell, with the customary obsequies being performed by priests who also believe in this philosophy.


The Prayer Hall is being increasingly used now and has proven to be a blessing, particularly during the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, where cremation is now mandated for those whose death certificates show that they passed away because of the virus.

PT: Tell us about the efforts needed to set it up, in terms of funding, permissions, et al..

Dinshaw Tamboly: The Municipal Corporation extended full cooperation in allocating a plot of land of our choice within the Worli Complex. Our architects were Messrs 'Epicons Consultants', and our building contractor Mr. Ashok Punjabi of A. P. Enterprises, who had been associated with the House of Godrej; all worked as a well-knit, dedicated and committed team and brought the project to fruition in very good time.

To fund the construction of the Prayer Hall, we initially circulated an appeal to various individuals, and

➤ some of us Trustees also dug into our own pockets. We also discussed the proposal with the Trustees of A H Wadia Trust and requested their support, in response to which they sanctioned a munificent donation of Rs. 15,000,000 (Rupees fifteen million). Without their generous donation it would not have been possible to complete the construction of the facility within 16 months.

**PT**: When did the Prayer Hall commence its services for the Community and how many has it serviced so far?

**Dinshaw Tamboly**: The Prayer Hall was commissioned in September 2015 and till the end of August 2021, it has enabled a dignified farewell to over 605 Zoroastrians who opted for an alternate method of disposal.

The following is the year-wise count of funeral services provided:

2015: 33 (September to December)

2016: 97

2017: 77

2018: 73

2019: 90 2020: 116

2021: 119 - (January to August)

TOTAL - 605 funeral services offered from September, 2015 to August, 2021

**PT**: What are the prayer services offered to community members and what are the charges?

**Dinshaw Tamboly**: The Prayer Hall Services and Maintenance Trust does not charge for use of the Prayer Hall. The facilities are provided gratis to families wishing to utilise the Hall for performing the 4-day obsequies. As the Hall is tucked-away in one corner of the Worli complex which is a secluded area, a sense of privacy is maintained where the prayers can be recited in tranquil surroundings.

Families using the facility can opt for Mobeds of their own choice to perform the ceremonies and those who are unable to do so, are free to utilise the services of Er. Framroze Mirza, the Coordinator of the Prayer Hall and his team of Mobeds. It has been clarified time and again that the charges for services rendered by the Mobeds, should be a matter between the Mobeds and the

families who opt for their services in which the Prayer Hall Services and Maintenance Trust has no role to play.

PT: What rules are to be observed (especially during Covid times) when entering the Hall?

Dinshaw Tamboly: Rules framed by the Government of Maharashtra and Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai have to be strictly observed. The maximum number of mourners permitted have to be adhered to. As of now, it is 20 persons.

For those who have passed away because of Covid, it is not permitted to bring the body into the Hall and the geh sarna prayers are recited alongside the hearse / ambulance, in which the body has been transported to the Hall. Subsequent obsequies can however be performed inside the Prayer Hall. All ceremonies for non-Covid deaths are performed as was done earlier, in the Prayer Hall.
